



What is Made in Queensland?

Made in Queensland is a \$20 million Queensland Government initiative supporting our manufacturing sector to become more internationally competitive and adopt innovative processes and technologies. Eligible manufacturing businesses will be able to apply for grants of between \$50,000 and \$2.5 million to become more productive, grow, innovate and create knowledge-based jobs for Queensland's future.

Made in Queensland grants will reimburse eligible businesses up to 50 per cent of the cost of implementing recommendations detailed in their Benchmarking Report and Action Plan.

This program complements the recently released *Advance Queensland Advanced Manufacturing 10-Year Roadmap and Action Plan* that will help manufacturers to transition to becoming an advanced manufacturer.

Who is eligible?

Made in Queensland is targeted at helping small to medium sized manufacturers. To be eligible, you must:

- be a manufacturing business based in Queensland
- employ between five and 200 people.

How do I get involved?

Applying for your Made in Queensland grant is a three-step process.

- 1 Visit www.statedevelopment.qld.gov.au/made-in-queensland to register your interest and review the program guidelines. Once we've confirmed your eligibility we'll get in touch.
- 2 Undertake the benchmarking process for your business to identify business improvement measures to grow and innovate. You will receive a Benchmarking Report and Action Plan.
- 3 Once you identify one or more projects from your Benchmarking Report and Action Plan that you want to pursue, make your application to Made in Queensland.
