



What is Made in Queensland?

Made in Queensland is a \$40 million Queensland Government initiative supporting our manufacturing sector to become more internationally competitive and adopt innovative processes and technologies. Eligible manufacturing businesses can apply for grants of between \$50,000 and \$2.5 million to help them become more productive, grow, innovate and create knowledge-based jobs for Queensland's future.

Made in Queensland grants will reimburse eligible businesses up to 50 per cent of the agreed project costs of implementing an approved project delivering leading edge or innovative equipment or systems.

This program complements the *Advance Queensland Advanced Manufacturing 10-Year Roadmap and Action Plan* that will help manufacturers to transition to becoming an advanced manufacturer.

Who is eligible?

Made in Queensland is targeted at helping small to medium sized manufacturers. To be eligible, you must:

- be a manufacturing business based in Queensland
- employ between five and 200 people;

How do I get involved?

Applying for your Made in Queensland grant is a two-stage competitive process.

- 1 Visit the [Made in Queensland website](#) to submit your Expression of Interest application. The EOI form will be available for four weeks from late April 2018.
- 2 Your EOI application will be assessed and ranked. The highest ranked applicants will be invited to submit detailed applications in July 2018.

Successful applicants will be notified in late 2018 for projects to commence from early 2019.
