## **KEY ISSUES**

- Since progressing to Stage 2: detailed proposal of the MLP framework in March 2016, the Museum
  proponent consortium consisting of Crossley Architects, Advanced Aquarium Technologies and the
  Queensland Maritime Museum has been unable to secure seed funding, an equity investor, operator
  or financier, or demonstrate the commercial viability of the concept.
- A key milestone deliverable, including an agreement with an equity investor, operator and seed funder to develop the detailed proposal, was due on 30 June 2018. On 29 June 2018, the proponent advised in writing that it is withdrawing from the MLP process (Attachment 3).
- A letter accepting the Museum proponent's withdrawal and termination of the Process Deed is
  provided at Attachment 1. This notice will formally close the MLP process and the proposal will be
  removed from the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning's
  website information.

#### Queensland Aquarium + Maritime Museum MLP

We refer to the PCG Meeting of 19 June 2018.

As foreshadowed at that meeting the proponents of the Queensland Aquarium and Maritime Museum (**QA+MM**) MLP have agreed amicably to dissolve QA+MM.

We intend ensuring an orderly withdrawal from the MLP proposal and have not ruled out the potential of an aquarium at some future time.

This will mean that upcoming Process Deed milestones will not be met and that we will take the required steps to withdraw from the MLP.
